**What is the Band of Angels?** The Band of Angels (BOA) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that was originally established at Fort Hood to raise funds and provide volunteers for programs and activities for Fisher House occupants.

**What does the Band of Angels do?** When the Fisher House was initially built, the BOA used to organize weekly meals for Fisher House residents. Over the years, as the need for meals diminished, the BOA has purchased miscellaneous items needed for the Fisher House (linens, patio furniture, holiday decorations, etc.) More recently the BOA has used the funds it has raised to assist Darnall Army Medical Center and Fort Hood soldiers and their families, in financial need, who have incurred expenses related to their medical treatment.

**How does the Band of Angels raise funds?** The BOA raises funds through various fundraising activities, membership dues, and tax deductible donations. Currently, our primary fundraiser is the sale of bricks for the commemorative brick terrace in the back of the Fisher House. For \$40, individuals, units, FRGs, companies or other organizations can purchase a brick to be inscribed with a personalized message and/or to commemorate a loved one.
