

Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center will conduct normal business operations on Wednesday, April 9. However, DES will close T.J. Mills Blvd. and Tank Destroyer from 11:45 a.m. – 4 p.m. for a Memorial Ceremony. This road closure may have an adverse impact on timely checking in to appointments for part of the morning and afternoon. Be advised that wait times at Fort Hood gates may be longer than normal; similar to what was experienced today. Staff is advised to use alternate gates during this time. All other gates, to include Santa Fe, Clear Creek and Rancier, will be open. The 79th Street gate will be open for Emergency Vehicle Traffic only.
