

COMING SOON, DRUG TAKE-BACK DAY!

The Fort Hood Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) in conjunction with Carl. R. Darnall Army Medical Center (CRDAMC) Department of Preventive Medicine, and Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP) will host the fourth bi-annual Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) drug Take-Back event. This is an opportunity for anyone with unused or expired medication to turn it in for safe disposal. The service is free and anonymous, with no questions asked.

Participants in DEA's six previous Take-Back Days turned in nearly 2.8 million pounds—almost 1,409 tons—of prescription drugs, most recently at more than 5,800 sites operated by over 4,300 of DEA's law enforcement partners.
