

**Post 9/11 GI BILL TRANSFERABILITY FOR MEDICAL  
BOARD/MEDICAL RETIREMENT SOLDIERS.**

- 1. Soldiers with 6 years of service but less than 10.**
  - a. Must be willing to serve an additional four years.**
  - b. Soldiers MUST request an exception to 4 year commitment PRIOR to receipt of Med Board results.**
  - c. POC will be Unit Career Counselor.**
  
- 2. Soldiers with 10 or more years of service wishing to make a transfer of education (TEB) benefits to a family member.**
  - a. Only after receipt of orders and prior to separation.**
  - b. “Soldiers must e-mail a copy of their separation orders and working DD214 to HRC, FIB at:
