Obstetric/Gynecological Nursing Course

We welcome the AMEDD Center and School's Obstetric Gynecological Nursing Course at CRDAMC. Starting this year candidates begin the process of earning the 66G additional skill identifier. CRDAMC is the Army's site for the 66G program. Candidates are required to complete a 16 week course consisting of eight weeks of didactics and eight weeks of clinical courses.

To meet training objectives and grade the performance of critical tasks, the 66G Program Directors use the Simulation Center to reinforce classroom learning. Program requirements cover the following scenarios:

- Management of Hypertension and Seizures
- Precipitous Delivery
- Neonatal Resuscitation.
- Post Partum Hemorrhage
- Mega Codes

Noelle (birthing simulator) and Baby Hal (neonatal simulator) are wireless models that provide feedback based on accepted treatment protocols. Debriefing sessions can be facilitated with audiovisual playback, with prior coordination.
